PUBLIC COMMENT:

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the City Council reconsider whether to reagendaize an Urgency Interim Ordinance of the City Council of the City of Elk Grove imposing a temporary moratorium on evictions and providing City residents with relief from disconnection and late fees for utilities, and that the City Council provide direction to staff as appropriate.

Section 5.a. of City Council Resolution 2010-24 (Rules of Procedures for the Conduct of City Council meetings) provides: "Actions of the City Council may be reconsidered within six months, only upon direction to the City Manager by a majority of Councilmembers who are eligible to participate on the item. An action is defined as one wherein an item is agendaized, considered, and a definitive action, by vote, is taken by the Council."

On March 18, 2020, the City Council voted to not adopt the above-referenced ordinance (4-1, Ly [no vote].) By majority vote of the City Council, the ordinance may be reconsidered and placed on a future City Council agenda, as directed by the City

Council. This agenda item is to determine **only** whether the ordinance is to be reconsidered and placed on a future City Council agenda. ***The City Council will not be taking final action to approve the ordinance at this meeting.*** The City Council may, however, provide direction on the content of a proposed ordinance for consideration at a future meeting.

4. ADJOURNMENT
