

CONSTRUCTION PAPER TOOL BELT

Materials you will need:

- Variety of Construction Paper (any color you like)
- String or Yarn
- Scissors
- Hole Puncher

Instructions on How-To Create your Tool Belt:

Start by drawing and cutting out the tools you want to include in your tool belt (similar to the picture below).

Using one piece of construction paper, position it with the longest side running horizontal. Simply make a small fold and cut the paper about 1-2 inches, 2 times – one on top of the other about a ½ inch apart. Repeat this step until you have 3 slots to place your tools into. (Again, feel free to refer to the picture below for reference)

Now its time to add your belt! Using your hole puncher, simply hole punch one hole in each upper corner of your tool pouch. Measure your waist and cut a piece of string or yarn that fits you. You will run the string or yarn through the holes in your construction paper (as seen in picture below).

The last step – add your tools to your tool belt and simply tie the tool belt around your waist, and voila, you are ready to get to work!
