NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

In accordance with the City of Northville's Liquor Management Ordinance (Chapter 5, Article II of the Code of Ordinances), the City of Northville's Liquor License Review Committee will hold a public hearing on Monday, August 2, 2021 at 6:00 p.m.

The Liquor Management Ordinance requires a public hearing and local government approval in the event of any new liquor license, transfer of ownership of a liquor license or application for a new permit. The purpose of this public hearing will be to solicit public comment on the following application:

Application request to transfer ownership and location of the Class C Liquor License with Sunday Sales (PM) Permit from Midnight's Inn, Inc. (in Escrow located at 3250 Wesson, Detroit, Wayne County, Business Id No. 142460) to Northville Marquis Theater Entertainment, LLC, to be located at 135 E. Main St., Northville, Wayne County Michigan; and Request a New SDM License, a new Sunday Sales (AM) Permit, and a New Dance/Entertainment Permit.

The meeting will be held via video conference as allowed by City Council's Local State of Emergency Declaration due to the COVID-19 pandemic, and in compliance with the Open Meetings Act.
