

Bancroft and Dungannon Blue-Box Recycling

What goes in the Co-Mingle Blue Box?

Aluminum: foil, pop cans, pie plates

Steel: cans, tins, empty aerosol cans

Glass: bottles/jars, clear or coloured

Polycoat: Drink boxes, paper coffee cups, milk and juice cartons

Film Plastic: plastic shopping bags, rinsed out milk pouches, bread bags (please put all bags into one plastic bag)

Hard plastic: jars, bottles, containers with H.D.P.E , P.E.T , or anything with the recycling symbol



Blue Boxes are available for purchase at the Municipal Office (8 Hastings Heritage Way) during regular business hours

What goes in the Cardboard Recycling?

Cardboard: flattened boxes, pizza boxes, egg cartons, brown paper bags

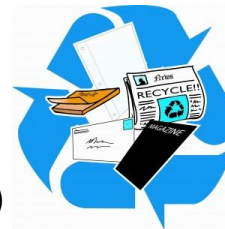
Boxboard: cereal boxes (remove liner), paper towel rolls, boxboard tubes

All cardboard recycling must be flattened and bound 2ft. x 2ft. x 2ft.



What Goes in the Fibre Blue Box?

Paper: writing paper, envelopes, non-metallic wrapping paper, books (please remove hard covers)



Newsprint: newspapers, flyers, phone books, magazines, catalogues

Blue Box Tips

- ✓ Rinse out containers before putting them in the Blue Box
- ✓ Be sure to properly sort your recycling (in accordance with what is outlined within this pamphlet)
- ✓ Keep your Blue Box clean so it doesn't attract pests
- ✓ Prevent Blue Box contents from blowing away by stacking items neatly and placing multiple film items into one bag



Common Mistakes

Please do **NOT** put the following items

in the Blue Box;

Broken Glass

Drinking Glasses

Pyrex

Light Bulbs

Window Glass

Ceramics

Containers from hazardous or petroleum products such as motor oil.

Hazardous waste days will be held periodically for hazardous waste items, and will be advertised accordingly.

Garbage and Blue Box Collection

Garbage and recycling collection take place according to the schedule below, except of statutory holidays.

Please place garbage and recycling curbside by **7 am**.

Please note that bins or bags weighing more than 20 kgs (44 lbs) and bags that break when lifted will not be collected.

Dungannon Ward residential collection,
excluding highway 28 E to Lakeview Road

Wednesday

Bancroft Ward residential collection, including
Highway 28 E to Lakeview Road

Thursday

Commercial Collection
(Recycling Only)

Please note that the Town of Bancroft has a clear bag policy in effect. All garbage in clear bags and recycling loose in Blue Bins.
