IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING APPLICATION FOR A JOINT U.S. BUREAU OF JUSTICE ASSISTANCE / SAMHSA GRANT TO FUND ENHANCEMENT OF SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE LANE COUNTY DRUG COURT PROGRAM AND DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO SIGN GRANT APPLICATION DOCUMENTS

**WHEREAS**, Drug Court is a criminal justice model that has proven to reduce criminal recidivism and costs of healthcare, food stamps, unemployment, child welfare and other costs to the taxpayers; and

**WHEREAS**, The U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) and the U.S. Department of Health & Human Services, Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMSHA), Center for Substance Abuse Treatment is accepting applications to enhance drug court treatment and

**WHEREAS**, a grant proposal is being prepared on behalf of the Lane County Adult Drug Court, and


**WHEREAS**, if the grant application is approved for funding the final award will be submitted to the Board for review, approval and acceptance;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

That the Board of County Commissioners approve application for a joint U.S. Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) and Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMSHA) grant and delegate authority to the County Administrator to sign the grant application documents.
