

BEFORE THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF LANE COUNTY, OREGON

ORDER AND RESOLUTION NO: 13-10-01-02 | IN THE MATTER OF TRANSFERRING UP  
TO \$10,000 FROM SPECIAL REVENUE  
FUND 260 OPERATIONAL CONTINGENCY  
TO MATERIALS & SERVICES WITHIN  
GENERAL EXPENSE FOR FIBER  
INFRASTRUCTURE IN VENETA.

**WHEREAS**, the Lane County Board of Commissioners established a policy for distributing video lottery economic development funds that is adopted in Lane Manual Chapter 4; and

**WHEREAS**, the Lane County Board of Commissioners has established an operational contingency within the Special Revenue Fund 260 in General Expense to be used for projects that may have a significant positive impact on local job creation; and

**WHEREAS**, the Lane County Board of Commissioners has reviewed the project and determined that it is in the public interest to support the installation of fiber infrastructure in Veneta; and

**WHEREAS**, it now appears to the Board of Commissioners that a transfer of up to \$10,000 from the Operational Contingency to Materials and Services within the Special Revenue Fund of General Expense is necessary to provide sufficient funds support this project; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners has met the legal requirements for this budget transfer, as per ORS 294.450(1)(2), which grants the authority to transfer appropriations within a fund via resolution provided that the need, purpose and amount of the transfer is stated and the amount does not exceed fifteen percent (15%) of total appropriations within the fund; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED and RESOLVED** that up to \$10,000 be transferred from the Special Revenue Fund Operational Contingency to the Materials and Services appropriation within General Expense as follows:
