IN THE MATTER OF APPLYING FOR AND
APPROVING ACCEPTANCE OF A
COMMUNITY PREVENTION GRANT
APPLICATION IN THE AMOUNT OF
\$200,000 FROM THE OREGON HEALTH
AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, Lane County Public Health and its Prevention Program work in tandem with Trillium Community Health, the local Coordinated Care Organization (CCO), in promoting healthy lifestyles and preventive healthcare in Lane County; and

WHEREAS, the Oregon Health Authority has published a grant opportunity for Community Prevention Programs based on Medicare and Medicaid Services funding; and

WHEREAS, these Community Prevention Programs will support Oregon's ongoing health system transformation; and


WHEREAS, Lane County Public Health and Prevention are well positioned to collaborate with the CCO in the delivery of community prevention activities related to the reduction of breast and colorectal cancer, the former being the most common form of cancer afflicting women in Oregon; and

WHEREAS, Lane Manual 21.137(2) requires that the Board of County Commissioners approve the application for grants in excess of \$100,000;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

1. Approve the Health & Human Services Public Health Prevention application for Oregon Health Authority grant funding for Community Prevention in the amount of \$200,000 for FY14-16; and
2. Authorize the County Administrator to sign the application and any acceptance documents.


