**WHEREAS**, evidence of Board approval of submissions is required with each application; and

**WHEREAS**, H&HS staff will review each RFP as it is released to determine if Lane County will apply for funds; and


**WHEREAS**, any grant awards as a result of this process will be brought before the Board for review and approval prior to acceptance
