

BEFORE THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF LANE COUNTY, OREGON

ORDER NO: 13-12-17-01

IN THE MATTER OF
RESTRUCTURING THE SUPERVISORY
AUTHORITY TEAM

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners regards community safety as a high priority;
and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners initially adopted a Supervisory Authority Team model as an appropriate framework that recognizes the need for coordination within the adult corrections system by adopting Order 02-11-26-1 on November 26th, 2002; and

WHEREAS, the particular membership of that team has been changed by the Board of Commissioners on several occasions in recognition of the changing nature of community corrections within Lane County and Oregon; and

WHEREAS, the Board has valued inclusiveness and equity as the driving principle in terms of determining membership; and

WHEREAS, the roles and responsibilities of the Supervisory Authority Team (SAT) were established in Board Orders 02-11-26-1 and amended by Order 08-3-12-8; and

WHEREAS, the Public Safety Coordinating Council (PSCC) analyzed the existing representation on the SAT and recommends to the Board of Commissioners that the composition of the SAT be restructured in recognition of reorganization of County departments and the implementation of newly passed legislation; and

WHEREAS, the PSCC analyzed the roles of the SAT including its current role in the initial development of the Community Corrections budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:


1. That the membership of the SAT be restructured to include the Sheriff, the Presiding Judge of the Circuit Court, and the County Administrator, or their respective designees, as voting members, and a County Commissioner as a non-voting liaison between the SAT and the Board of Commissioners.
2. That the four SAT members, and a representative of the reentry provider community appointed by the PSCC Chair comprise the PSCC Budget Committee, which would be charged with developing the initial Community Corrections Plan budget for the approval of the PSCC to recommend to the Board of County Commissioners for final approval.
