ADMINISTRATOR TO SIGN THE GRANT  
APPLICATION AND SUBSEQUENT GRANT  
AWARD DOCUMENTS

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners approves all grant applications in excess of \$100,000; and

**WHEREAS**, the grant application is for \$463,363; and

**WHEREAS**, the State Interoperability Executive Council has a one-time funding opportunity that advances statewide radio communications interoperability in Oregon; and

**WHEREAS**, Lane County is a member of the Lane Radio Interoperability Group which maintains a regional trunked radio system with interoperability amongst all agencies using the trunked radio system; and

**WHEREAS**, interoperability of the LRIG UHF and Linn-Benton 700MHz trunked radio systems with other local agency radio systems providing public safety services enhances the safety and health of Lane, Linn and Benton counties.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

1. Approve applying for a State Interoperability Executive Council Interoperability (SIEC) Grant for interagency radio interoperability using ISSI technology; and delegating authority to the County Administrator to sign the grant application and subsequent grant award documents.
