ORDER NO: 17-10-17-01

IN THE MATTER OF ACCEPTING A DRUG FREE COMMUNITIES GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$625,000 FOR THE PERIOD SEPTEMBER 30, 2014 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 29, 2019 FROM THE SUBSTANCE ABUSE AND MENTAL HEALTH ADMINISTRATION

**WHEREAS**, the County has adopted as a strategic priority the promotion of a Safe and Healthy County; and

**WHEREAS**, Lane Manual 20.650 requires that the Board of County Commissioners must approve grant acceptance in excess of \$100,000; and

**WHEREAS**, the grant to be accepted from the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Administration will support one of the BCC/BoH adopted Community Health Improvement Plan goals and/or strategies;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

1. Approve the acceptance of a Drug Free Communities grant from the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Administration in a not-to-exceed amount of \$625,000 for the period September 2014 through September, 2019; and
2. Delegate authority to the Department of Health & Human Services to draw down this funding on a quarterly basis, for the duration of the grant.
