ORDER NO: 21-05-04-07

ORDER / IN THE MATTER OF
ESTABLISHING A SAFETY CORRIDOR
ON LONDON ROAD PURSUANT TO
SECTION 2(1)(C) OF CHAPTER 501,
OREGON LAWS 2019

WHEREAS, Section 2(1)(a) of Chapter 501, Oregon Laws 2019 authorizes the Oregon Department of Transportation to establish a safety corridor pilot program allowing counties to designate as safety corridors roads over which counties are the road authority; and

WHEREAS, Section 2(1)(b) directs the County Safety Corridor Advisory Group to select up to five counties to participate in the pilot program; and

WHEREAS, Section 2(1)(c) authorizes the county governing body of a county selected to participate in the pilot program to designate one segment of county road that is between 2 and 10 miles long a safety corridor; and

WHEREAS, the safety corridor program is a proven countermeasure to reduce fatal and severe-injury crashes; and


WHEREAS, Lane County adopted a Transportation Safety Action Plan in 2017, making a commitment to reduce fatal and severe-injury collisions through engineering, education, and enforcement actions; and

WHEREAS, Lane County implemented a Fatal Crash Investigation Team (FCIT) in 2017 which evaluates every fatality on a Lane County road to consider engineering, enforcement, and education actions that would help prevent future fatalities; and

WHEREAS, the FCIT sponsored the London Road Safety Corridor application which was approved by the County Safety Corridor Advisory Group on February 18, 2021, based on fatal and severe-injury crashes on the first seven miles of Long Road exceeding statewide averages; NOW, THEREFORE,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that London Road, between milepost 0 at Latham Drive and milepost 7 at Cottage Grove Reservoir Road, is designated as a safety corridor pursuant to section 2(1)(c) of chapter 501, Oregon Laws 2010.
