ORDER NO: 21-07-13-04

IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE OREGON STATE MARINE BOARD AND THE LANE COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES ON THE WATERWAYS OF LANE COUNTY, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$948,764 AND DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE

WHEREAS, the Oregon State Marine Board has requested an intergovernmental agreement with the Lane County Sheriff's Office, a two year agreement in the amount of \$948,764 for law enforcement services on the waterways of Lane County; and

WHEREAS, Lane Manual requires that the Board of County Commissioners approve for execution an agreement which exceeds \$150,000

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

1. Lane County, through the Lane County Sheriff's Office is approved to enter into the intergovernmental agreement with the Oregon State Marine Board, over two years, in the amount of \$948,764
2. The County Administrator is delegated authority to sign and execute the agreement with Oregon State Marine Board.
