**Consent:**

**1. Presentation and request for funding assistance for the Ogden's YCC (Your Community Connection). (Presenter: Julee Smith, YCC Executive Director)**

Julee Smith gave a presentation on the YCC and requested funding assistance.

**2. Discussion and possible action to enter into an agreement for Municipal Advisory Services with Zions Public Finance, Inc. (Presenter: Bill Cobabe)**

Bill Cobabe: this is a renewal of a contract for services that we have had. There is no cost until we need the service. This contract is saying that these are our people.

Motion was made by CM Gibson to enter into an agreement for Municipal Advisory Services with Zions Public Finance, Inc. as stated for five years. 2<sup>nd</sup> by CM Urry.

**3. Discussion and possible action on Change Order #2 for the Evergreen Strom Drain Project, with contactor Mike Humphreys Construction in the amount of \$164,949.45. (Presenter: Dana Shuler with Jones & Associates)**

Dana Shuler: last year we awarded Mike Humphreys the project and he did potholing and there were more utilities in Pleasant View Drive and 1325 W. We did a changed order and looked at options. We got prices from Mike Humphreys and he is ready to work now. It is a \$60K increase for the additional work and pipe. This is for the existing and future water. This abandons the pond. Bill Cobabe: this water will end up at the Multi-Sports Park. Tyson Jackson: this water goes to your park to water it.

Motion was made by CM Gibson to approve the Change Order #2 for the Evergreen Strom Drain Project, with contactor Mike Humphreys Construction in the amount of \$164,949.45. 2<sup>nd</sup> by CM Hansen. Voting aye: CM Burns, CM Gibson, CM Hansen, & CM Urry. 4-0

**Other Business:**

Ryon Hadley: the good weather in increase the auto burglaries. CM Hansen: we need to get the word out as neighbors. Ryon Hadley: it could be a scout project to distribute emergency numbers. In March there were 994 calls for service, 184 citations, and 7 custodial arrests. We are getting more criminal case in court than traffic cases.

Tyson Jackson: a traffic cop was at our work area and I appreciated that.

CM Gibson: Mosquito Abatement is starting to kill mosquitos.

CM Burns: we had the first Founder's Day Meeting for 2018. We will not be having the fun run or the breakfast.
