4. Go to your inbox and open the verification email and click "Verify Email". Then select "Continue" to log in.
5. Select your billing organization and follow the prompts for linking your bill.
6. Once your bill is added to your account, you can add another bill, view and pay your bill online, or setup a recurring auto payment schedule.

Continuing Questar Gas Project

Remember Questar Gas has begun construction on a gas line. The project location starts at the Park-n-Ride at the intersection of US-89 and Pleasant View Drive in Pleasant View City, and continue eastward along Pleasant View Drive to Lomond View Drive. At Lomond View Drive, the pipeline will head east to the regulator station site at 165 E Lomond View Drive. Construction is anticipated to last through the end of September 2017.

The following positions are to be filled at the **2017 Pleasant View City's Municipal Elections:**

City Council	4-yr term

Qualifications for a candidate are:

1. Registered voter.
2. Resident of the Pleasant View for a period of 12 consecutive months immediately preceding the date of the election.
3. No mentally incompetent person, any person convicted of a felony, or any person convicted of treason or a crime against the elective franchise may not hold office in this state until the right to hold elective office is restored.

To become a candidate, a Declaration of Candidacy shall be filed in person at City Hall between June 1st and 7th on Monday thru Friday from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM.
