Recycling Update & Request



Please be cognizant of what you're placing into your recycling can. The landfill has had an increase in non-recyclable items being placed into recycle cans. This causes more work and issues at the landfill where they then have to sort through the materials. If the County continues to have problems with recycling, they could decide in the future to no longer offer the program.

A FEW REMINDERS.....



PLEASE DO NOT PLACE THE FOLLOWING ITEMS INTO YOUR RECYCLING CONTAINER:

Food, glass, household trash, plastic bags or film, pizza boxes, Styrofoam, foam cups or containers, clothes/shoes, yard waste, motor oil, household chemicals, construction debris (dirt, rocks, sod, concrete, etc.), tires, batteries, propane bottles, tanks or barrels of any kind, furniture, appliances, or electronics.



Please place your container in the proper place; the ideal location is to the left or right of your driveway as close to the road as possible. Be sure the handle faces your house. Containers must be placed at least 6 feet away from other containers or objects (i.e. mail boxes, light posts, fences, etc.)



Please do not block containers with vehicles. It is best to place containers at least 20 feet away from any vehicle.



Containers cannot be overloaded. If the lid on your container is open more than 2 inches, it is overloaded. If you need another container, please call the city's Public Works Dept. for options.

Cardboard boxes **must** be broken down, and preferably cut into small pieces. Please do not lay flattened boxes on top of container.

A \$10 Non-Resident fee will be added to the cost for all non-residents

Teams will be selected through the ***Mutual buddy requests** which allow for each participant to request a friend to be on the same team, so long as that same friend requests the participant. For example, Joey requests Tommy during registration, and Tommy requests Joey. If the mutual buddies were paired during registration, then they are assigned to the same team. All other team member assignments are made by random placement.
