<u>Dana Shuler</u>: this is with the Rulon White Blvd. extension and deals with UDOT because they will help us reconstruct the intersection if we move the utility boxes. We received two bids. Our engineer estimate was \$240K. We recommend Sorensen. They are a reputable contractor.
