NO PROOF OF INSURANCE AMENDMENT INFORMATION

If you did not have insurance coverage at the time of the ticket, you **MAY** be eligible to have this charge amended to a lesser offense, if you complete the below requirements and are approved by a City Prosecutor. If you are interested in amending your No Proof of Insurance charge, the following items **must be completed no later than 60 days from the date of offense.**

** Please be advised that the amendment fee is \$100, plus court costs, and is due in one payment at the time of the amendment. **

- Obtain current liability insurance coverage for yourself or your vehicle.**

If you no longer own a vehicle, you may purchase a non-owner's insurance policy that will cover you as the driver of another's vehicle.

- Bring proof of insurance and money/credit card to pay for fines and fees to your next court date. This must be completed no later than 60 days from the date of offense.**

IF YOU WERE INVOLVED IN AN ACCIDENT:

- Proof of Restitution or Letter of Release required in cases involving an accident.**

If you were involved in an accident at the time of your ticket, you will be required to show proof of restitution for damages to the other party involved, or a letter signed by the other party releasing you from any liability for the accident.

If you desire to amend your No Proof of Insurance charge to a lesser offense, the assessed fine is generally **\$100 + court costs**, and must be paid in full at the time of amendment.

***Nothing contained herein shall constitute an agreement to amend your citation. All amendments are subject to the sole discretion of the prosecutor.**
