We are happy to announce that Aga Park and Fountain Mesa Park upgrades are complete and the playgrounds are now open to all visitors.

In July, the City of Fountain installed our very first all-inclusive playground incorporating wheelchair accessible play equipment and sensory activities inside of Aga Park.



In November, the City of Fountain completed the installation of a new, fully accessible playground in Fountain Mesa Park. The new equipment includes play features that ensure all of Fountain's children have the opportunity to play, explore, learn and exercise.



We have completed the installation of new lighting at Aga Park and Fountain Mesa Park. New lighting will also be installed at the Skate Park and Volleyball courts inside of John Metcalfe Park in the coming months.

### **John Metcalfe Park**

We are excited to announce that our skate park is getting some new awesome upgrades. Construction to the Skate Park is expected to begin in May and will be completed by early June. The Skate Park will be closed during this time.

The north parking lot at will be extended.

We are hoping to install new ADA compliant play structures sometime in 2022.

We will be redesigning and renovating the restrooms at Aga Park. Construction is planned to begin in the coming months. A new shade canopy will also be installed by the Splash Pad.
