

COUNCIL PRE-MEETING

Mayor Powell began the pre-meeting session at 5:32 p.m. Present: Councilmembers Bates, Freel, Hopkins, Huber, Johnson, Lutz, and Mayor Powell. Absent: Pacheco and Walsh.

Mayor Powell began the meeting by presenting some possible agenda changes for the July 9, 2019 work session. Several agenda items were rescheduled.

City Manager Napier then said that he anticipated that excess 1%#15 funds would be adequate to pay for the Casper Police training tool. Council indicated support for the funding source.

Councilmember Bates asked if Council could have a moment of silence to honor recently passed City staff members Scott Low and Brad Menzel and Korean War Veteran Corporal DeMaret Marston Kirtley. Mayor Powell indicated that it would be appropriate to do so.

Councilmember Hopkins shared with City Manager Napier a complaint of a weed problem on North Jackson. Councilmember Freel asked about the scoreboard at the Crossroads ball fields. Tim Cortez, Parks and Recreation Manager indicated that repairs had been scheduled. City Manager Napier stated that the traffic light at CY and Pheasant was being examined. Councilmember Bates asked about the jurisdictional responsibilities for striping road segments, which City Manager Napier addressed. Councilmember Bates asked if Council had discussed the alley by 'B' Street in the vicinity of the Rescue Mission. Councilmember Freel asked about the process to have an alley vacated. Andrew Beamer, Public Services Director, stated that a utility easement would be necessary for that area because of the location of a water main. Chief McPheeters said that he felt some of the citizen concerns about the area had been addressed. Chief McPheeters stated that vehicles had been removed, and other work had been done to improve the alley, and also shared that some home owners would likely still wish to access their properties via the alley. Councilmember Huber asked how the City of Casper paid for Hall of Justice expenses, which City Manager Napier addressed.

City Manager Napier spoke briefly about the ordinance on the agenda regarding wireless facilities. Mayor Powell asked if the item needed to be postponed. City Manager Napier indicated that the item could continue to move forward, and that adjustments could occur during the process, if needed.

Mayor Powell adjourned the meeting at 5:51 p.m.
