- Submit all supporting documentation by the application deadline

Police Officer Minimum Requirements:

- Pay a \$25.00 non-refundable application processing fee
- Must be 21 years old by date of written exam; maximum age of under 35 years unless the age limit is reached after being placed on Eligibility list (unless otherwise exempt by Statute)
- Must be a U.S. Citizen
- Must possess a valid driver's license
- Must have a high school diploma or equivalent
- Must possess an Associate's Degree. In lieu of an Associate's Degree, you must have one of the following:
 1. 60 semester hours of credit toward a Bachelor's Degree from an institution of higher learning accredited by the U.S. Department of Education
 2. Have served for 24 months of honorable active duty in the United States Armed Forces and not have been discharged dishonorably or under circumstances other than honorable
 3. Have served for 180 days of active duty in the United States Armed Forces in combat duty recognized by the Department of Defense and has not been discharged dishonorably or under circumstances other than honorable
- Applicants must submit proof of passing the POWER Test within ONE YEAR PRIOR to the application deadline
- Vision correctable to 20/20 in both eyes
- Pass a comprehensive pre-employment screening process to include: background investigation, polygraph, psychological and medical examination with drug testing

Optional Orientation:

An optional orientation will be held on Wednesday, October 13, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. The orientation will be presented through a Zoom Meeting. Meeting details will be provided to those who have purchased an application by Wednesday, October 6, 2021. The orientation will be recorded and made available to anyone interested in learning more about the department and the position of police officer.

Virtual Testing Information:

Your exam will be offered electronically and you will take the exam in your own home. There will be multiple sessions offered and each will be proctored virtually. All sessions will be offered during business hours the week of November 29th – it is your responsibility to ensure you have the flexibility to test during these times.
